Supply chain information:

Supply chain information included in Rapid Response reports is based on the latest public versions of mill disclosures, recent export data, and grievance logs. Mighty Earth encourages companies to send updated versions of mill disclosures as soon as they become available and to share any decision to suspend relations with a given group/company listed in those mill disclosures with rapidresponse@mightyearth.org.

Mighty Earth is now including biofuel companies in the supply chain tables of Rapid Response reports, as these companies have both direct and indirect trading relationships with groups highlighted in these reports and should be filing grievances on these cases. [Rapid Response report 39](#) included a case of deforestation in the PT Sawit Sukses Sejati (formerly PT Anugerah Langkat Makmur) concession.

PT Sawit Sukses Sejati is 90% controlled through the British Virgin Islands (BVI) offshore holding company Jalan Abesin Limited. See [Rapid Response report 39](#) for further ownership analysis.

Following this Rapid Response case, several companies (including [Musim Mas](#)) asked one of their suppliers (PT Sumber Tani Agung, STA Group) to stop sourcing from PT Sawit Sukses Sejati.

Following recent engagement with Mighty Earth, BASF has taken action to suspend the PT Anugerah Langkat Makmur 2 mill due to NDPE policy violations. PZ Cussons is still investigating the case.

The supply chain information in the table above uses data from public mill lists or other public data to determine which traders and consumer brands source from companies connected to the PT Sawit Sukses Sejati concession.

Mapping Analysis



The above Planet imagery shows deforestation in the PT Sawit Sukses Sejati concession between January of 2022 (left) and December of 2023 (right).

Our recent research shows that there is now a Palm Oil Mill (POM) located in the PT Sawit Sukses Sejati concession area which has started appearing in publicly available mill lists. The Universal Mill List (UML) code is PO1000014636 with the coordinates 1.007,99.0183 – see Google image below.
